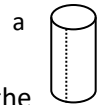

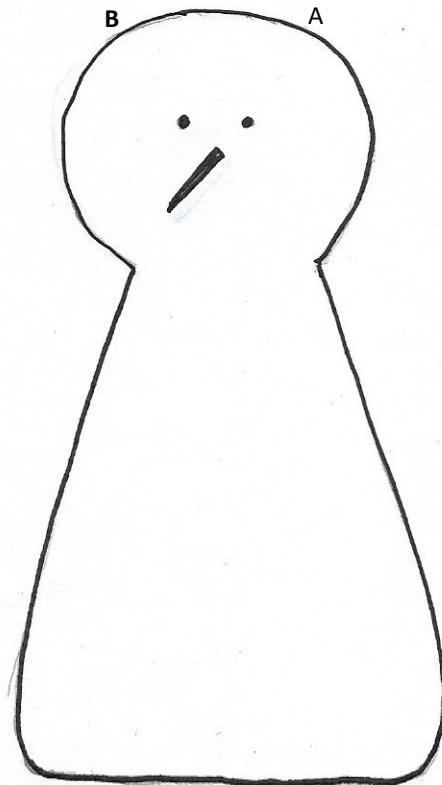
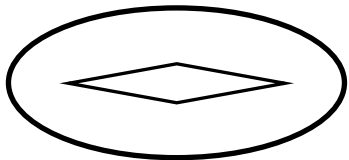
Read all instructions before starting

NO FUSIBLE REQUIRED! FREEZER PAPER IS USED!

1. Trace one snowman on smooth side of fusible interfacing, reverse and trace again. Iron to the wool. Cut both pieces on the lines. With wrong sides together, pin at the top and bottom to keep edges together. Starting at A blanket stitch around edge of snowman body stopping at B. Tie a knot to secure stitch, do not cut thread. Lightly stuff body and head. Stitch closed, secure with a knot.
2. Add French knot eyes. Embroider nose. Add dry blush with a cotton swab for cheeks. Stitch beads on the front of snowman.
3. Assemble hat: Cut out one rectangle from black wool. Roll into a cylinder overlapping $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Stitch long side or glue closed to form top hat (see diagram a). Make 6 - $\frac{1}{4}$ " snips across the bottom of the cylinder Cut out two brims from black wool. Glue together, set aside and let dry. Cut the opening in the center of oval as shown on pattern. Insert snipped edge of cylinder into the brim opening. Place a dab of tacky glue to the cylinder wool and fold back to glue to the brim. Let dry. Position and stitch hat to the snowman using photo as a guide. It will just rest on the head. Wrap yarn around hat close to the brim and glue in place. Trim excess yarn.
4. Put a knot in the ends of scarf yarn and tie around the neck.
5. Create sparklers by dabbing Tacky Glue to one end of pipe cleaner. Cut garland in $1\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces. Wrap one around the glue being careful to get glue only on the middle of the garland so the "needles" do not get matted. Repeat for second sparkler. Insert into the top of the hat. Bend inserted end of sparkler as needed for height.
