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
2016 June Ornament of the Month

The pattern is a free download for you to print and use. It is only available free during the month it is offered. Each month a new pattern will be posted. Kits can be ordered anytime at:


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The kit will contain all the fabric needed to make the ornament, Paper backed fusible and any embellishing items for that month if applicable.

BLANKET STITCH — TAKE AN UPRIGHT
STITCH TO THE RIGHT OF WHERE THE
THREAD CAME UP WITH THE NEEDLE
POINTED DOWN, KEEPING THE THREAD
UNDER THE NEEDLE AND COMING OUT ON
THE LINE.

Ornament of the Month

PATTERN IS REVERSED FOR FUSIBLE TECHNIQUE. Lay out and identify all pieces before cutting.

I use Soft Fuse, a paperbacked fusible and lots of steam!

Optional finishing instruction will be available for those wanting to create a wall hanging. If you wish to do this, it isn't necessary to fuse the backing piece or blanket stitch around it.

- 1. Trace all pattern pieces onto paper side of fusible.
- 2. Rough cut around the pieces and fuse to the back of the appropriate wool color. Cut shapes exactly on the lines. Remove paper.
- 3. Position all the pieces on the backing wool, fuse and cut out. A damp press cloth and steam can helps the fusible to adhere better if the wool is thick.
- 4. Blanket stitch around each piece and the outside edge.
- 5. Add a hanger. Enjoy the work of your hands.

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
