

TREE SKIRT OR CANDLE MAT

Cutting and assembly instructions

Please read before beginning

We use steam when fusing pieces together

1. Trace 3 sets of holly leaves onto paper side of fusible and iron to corresponding wool. Cut out on the lines. Remove paper from all pieces. **NOTE: BERRIES WILL BE ADDED NEXT MONTH!!**
2. Trace pattern for background on dull side of freezer paper by flipping pattern piece to create circle. Iron shiny side to fabric and cut out on the line. Remove paper and **KEEP FOR THE NEXT KIT INSTALLMENT!**
3. Fold circle in half and place a pin on each side of the fold (figure 1). Unfold and refold in half matching pins together (figure 2) placing more pins as before. Continue folding and pinning until you have 8 pins evenly spaced around the edge of the circle (figures 3, 4 & 7).
4. Use one leaf of each color create clusters and position on each pin (figure 5). You will end up having 4 clusters with the berries on the edge and 4 clusters with the berries in the center. Iron in place. Stitch around edges of the detail and embellish as shown (figure 6). More embellishments will be added next month.
5. Enjoy the work of your hands and patiently wait for next month. **Complete pattern with cover will be in the next month's mailing**

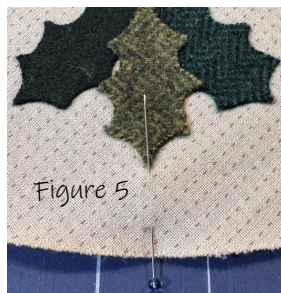

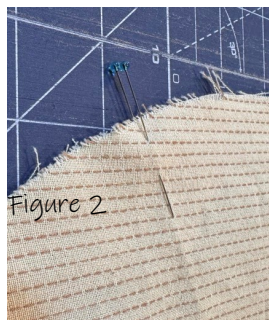

line stitch

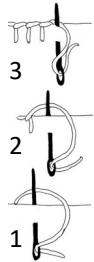

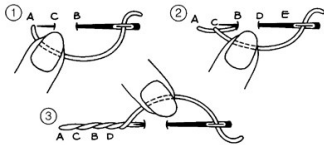

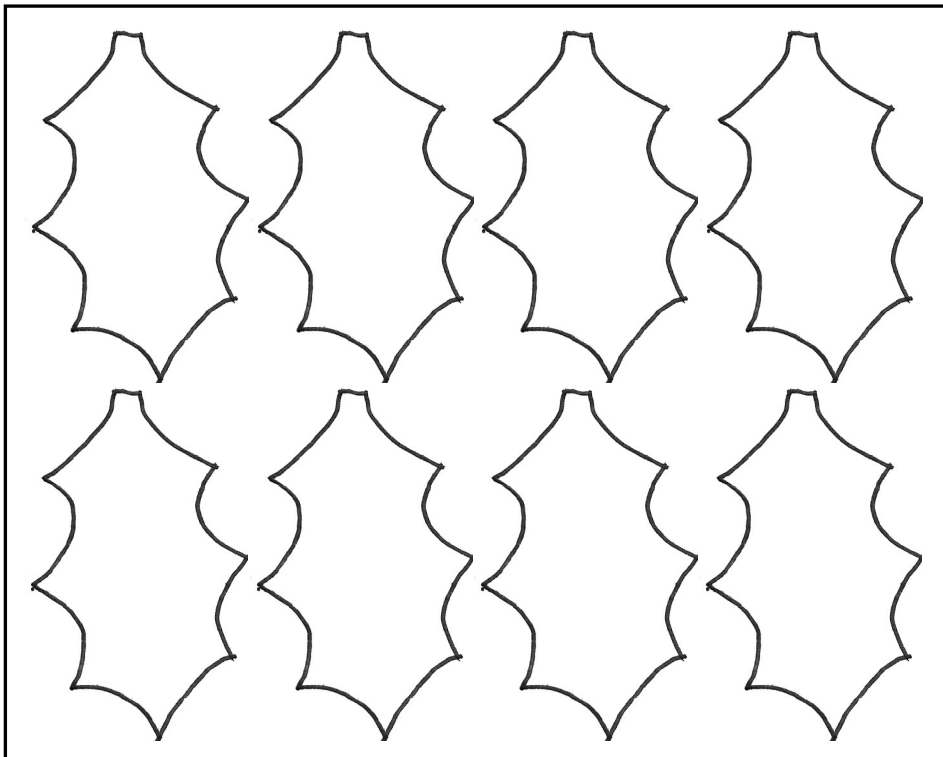
Blanket stitch - Take an upright stitch to the right of where the thread came up with the needle pointed up, keeping the thread under the needle and coming out on the line or the edge of your wool.



Outline stitch - Bring needle up at A and insert at B. Bring needle back out at C halfway from A to B. Go in at D and back out B. Continue in the same manner.



Trace 3 sets of leaves.

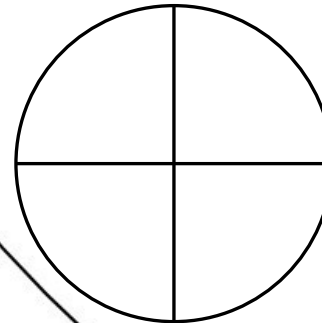
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Trace 4 quarters to create a circle on freezer paper. Do not discard! You will need the template for the next portion.



If these lines measure 1" you have printed the pattern to the right size. Always check before you begin cutting.
